## 2018 Financial Report

In 2017, the Inglewood Beach Club had 117 current members and 14 guest members.



Our largest expense was removing the dead trees at the beach, as voted on at the Annual Meeting. This year we plan to replace the swim line and buoys and make repairs to the swim platform. Our goal is to save as much as possible to be prepared for any changes that the trail construction will impose on the beach.

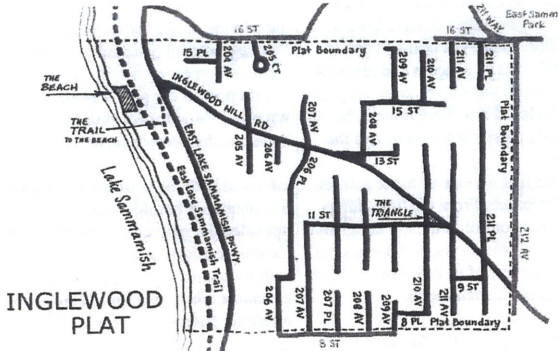
